



EIZO Returns to Full Production Capacity

We extend deepest sympathy to all those impacted by the seismic events on the Noto Peninsula in Ishikawa Prefecture, Japan on January 1, 2024. We sincerely hope for the earliest possible restoration and recovery of all affected areas.

Hakusan, Japan, February 22, 2024 - EIZO Corporation (TSE: 6737) would like to update the information regarding the impact of the earthquake on its headquarters and factory located in Hakusan City, Ishikawa Prefecture, as well as the factories of EIZO MS Corporation (a group company situated in Hakui and Nanao, Ishikawa Prefecture).

1. Operation Status of Business Sites

(1) EIZO Corporation Headquarters and Factory

Operations have resumed normally since January 4.

(2) EIZO MS Corporation (Hakui Factory)

As anticipated, operations have resumed normally since February 13.

(3) EIZO MS Corporation (Nanao Factory)

Production operations resumed at 50% capacity starting January 22, with reduced hours. As of February 19, operations have scaled up to 85% capacity with normal hours. Full production capacity, as planned, is expected to be restored by March 1. However, it's important to note that water supply challenges persist in some locations. EIZO's primary focus remains on prioritizing the well-being and safety of our employees.

2. Impact on Business Performance

The amount of impact caused by the earthquake corresponds to the forecast disclosed on January 31, 2024, in the "Notice Concerning the Impact on our Business Performance of the Noto Peninsula Earthquake of 2024."

Furthermore, EIZO consider this report to be the final report on the effects of the 2024 Noto Peninsula earthquake. Thanks to the significant cooperation of EIZO's customers, suppliers, and all other relevant parties, it is anticipated that EIZO will be able to return to normal operation promptly. EIZO would like to take this opportunity to express EIZO's heartfelt gratitude for your generous assistance.
